lam directed to state that on consideration of the observations and recommendations of the Expert Committee of the All India Board of Management Studies which visited the college on 26th May, 1993 and further recommendations made by the Chairperson, All India Board of Management Studies, the All India Council for Technical Education has accorded approval for extension of its earlier approval to the Adhiyamaan College of Engineering, Hasur, Tamilmadu for conduct of full-time and part-time MBA Courses with an annual intake of 40 each during the academic year 1993-94 subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- 1. There should be a separate Governing Council for the MBA programme. It will be constituted and the Chairman appointed as per the guidelines laid down/prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
- 2. The infrastructural, instructional and other facilities including teaching staff, equipment etc. should be provided as per AICTE norms prescribed from time to time.
- 3. An independent building with required space as per AICTE norms should be provided exclusively for conducting the MBA programme. Separate rooms for faculty and smaller rooms for elective courses should be provided before the start of the Second Year of the programme.
- 4. An independent library should be established for the MBA Programme with adequate number of titles, books, journals (both Indian & Foreign) etc as per AICTE norms.
- 5. A separate computer Centre with adequate number of PCs, Printers etc. should be established for the MBA Programme.
- No new course shall be started and no alteration in the approved intake of students in the MBA programme will be made without the prior approval of the AICTE.
- 7. The teaching faculty should be given pay-scales as per the USC/AICTE guidelines prescribed from time to time.
- 8. The admissions shall be made as per norms and guidelines of the AICTE/ Govt. of India by the Competent Authority, namely, the State Govt./ University concerned as the case may be.

- 9. The Faculty/teaching staff should be recruited on All-India basis by open selection as per procedure, qualifications and experience etc. prescribed by the AICTE from time to time. State based selections would be permissible for such posts for which the State Government prescribes "State-based Selection" as a general policy.
- 10. That tuition and other fees will be charged as prescribed by the State Govt. within the overall criteria prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
- 11. No Capitation fee or donation shall be charged from the Students/guandians of the students in any form.
- 12. A separate account shall be maintained for the MBA programme and the same shall be audited annually by a Chartered Accountant and be open for inspection by the AICTE or Board or person a Schorised by it.
- 13. The teaching and other staff should be selected according to procedures, qualifications and experience(s) prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
- 14. The Management shall strictly follow any further conditions as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.
- 15. An Endowment Fund of Rs. 10 lakks should be created exclusively for the MBA programme and fixed deposit receipt should be in the combined name of the College and the Director of Technical Education, Govt. of Tamilnadu, Madras.
- 16. The College by virtue of the approval given by AICTE shall not automatically become claimant to any financial grant or assistance from the Central or State Government.

This approval is further subject to full-compliance with the "SCHEME" as prescribed by the Supreme Court in its judgement dated 4.4.93 with regard to WP(c) No. 607 of 1992 in the case of Unni Krishnan, J.P. and others etc. etc. vs. State of Andhra Pradesh and others etc. and the related guidelines and criteria as may be issued by the AICTE, UGC or the Central Government from time to time.
